## ORGANICS GREEN CART

-  All food waste
-  Coffee grinds, filters, and tea bags (no coffee pods)
-  Parchment paper and food wraps
-  Pizza boxes
-  Shells: egg, fish, nut
-  Soiled napkins/paper towels
-  Sugar, flour, potato bags
-  Residential cooking oil or fat (small amounts that absorb into the contents of the cart)
-  Leaves, brush, and plants
-  Pine needles, pine cones and tree nuts

- NO plastic bags
- NO milk cartons
- NO metal or glass
- NO diapers, wipes or personal hygiene products






## RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS—BAG 1

-  Aluminum foil and plates
-  Glass bottles and jars (lids off)
-  Metal food cans
-  Milk cartons and jugs (caps off)
-  All plastic bags, shrink wrap and bubble wrap
-  Plastic containers (#1,2, 4 & 5)
-  Detergent jugs and body care containers (caps off)
-  Other non-refund carton beverages (soy/rice)

 Return all refundable beverage containers to an Enviro Depot™ for your refund (or place in Blue Bag 1)

- NO paper
- NO plastic cutlery or straws
- NO disposable cups
- MUST be rinsed and clean

## RECYCLABLE PAPER— BAG 2

-  Boxboard (cereal and cracker boxes)
-  Cardboard (flatten & bundled)
-  Paper egg cartons & coffee trays
-  Envelopes
-  Magazines, catalogues, phone books and paper back novels\*
-  Newsprint and flyers
-  Paper (shredded and whole)

\*Remove covers from hard cover books first before placing in bag.

- NO plastic
- NO disposable cups
- NO milk cartons
- MUST be clean and dry

## LANDFILL GARBAGE BAG

-  Broken glass (safely package label, place beside garbage bag)
-  Bubble mailers
-  Candy wrappers
-  Cardboard cans (plastic lids can be recycled)
-  Cigarette butts
-  Diapers and personal hygiene products
-  Disposable cups and coffee pods
-  Disposable wipes, masks and gloves
-  Drinking straws
-  Foil gift wrap and ribbon
-  Potato chip bags
-  Clothing/Textiles (consider reuse)
-  Toothpaste tubes and tooth brush

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Contact your waste authority or municipality for residential drop-off locations in your area.
